Why Should I go to N.O.A.C.?

The National Order of the Arrow Conference is something of an Arrowman's pilgrimage. **Imagine 8,000 of your fellow Brothers descending on one University for an entire week.** There is more fun stuff to do than one has time for, from national activities and incredible shows, training from the best instructors in the nation, patch trading upon patch trading, ceremonies evaluation and national completion, and finally a sense of fellowship and brotherhood unlike any other Order of the Arrow event you have will ever attend.

What are the details of the Cahuilla Lodge contingent trip?

Cahuilla Lodge is sponsoring a contingent that will include your registration fee, airline travel from Southern California to Detroit Michigan, transportation to the University and 1 day of early housing in Lansing. Our contingent will leave July 29th 2012 and arrive back in Southern California on August 4th 2012

How much does N.O.A.C. cost?

The final fee is not established. The fee for the event has not been set just yet and we cannot book our flights until January 2012. However, we expect the price will be approximately \$1050.00 depending on flights and housing in Lansing, if you attend with the Lodge contingent. If you travel privately to NOAC your cost will be the conference fee and personal travel. **Your conference and airline deposit of \$200.00 is due NOW. \$460 is due on April 1st 2012. \$350 is due on May 1st 2012 and the remainder is due May 31st 2012. The Lodge will be paying at least the last \$200 for all youth!! All fees are paid directly to Boy Scout Headquarters in Redland.**

We will have no problem accommodating you attendance. Just know that Cahuilla Lodge will be required to have 2 youth attend for every 1 adult. If we do not have enough youth attending, we will have to select adults to go. The best thing to do if you are over 21 is recruit 2 youth to attend N.O.A.C.

Also, Cahuilla Lodge will be given a quota based on our Lodge membership. We will have to apply for additional attendee spots. Normally, this happens in the Spring when other Lodges do not fill their quotas
