Ted Green Arrowman of the Year

Purpose

Annually, Cahuilla Lodge # 127 will recognize a youth and adviser for their exemplary service over the calendar year. The purpose of this honor is to award people whose service to the Order has the same spirit as Ted Green, Past Lodge Adviser, who passed away while in office and service to the program. His dedication to the Order was an inspiration for many and this award lives on in his memory.

Procedures

- 1. There is to be a youth chairman appointed by the First Vice-Chief. The youth is the person that will carry out all the duties of the selection process for the Ted Green Arrowman of the Year. An appointed adviser will guide the youth in the selection process.
- 2. Any Active member may nominate another active member of the Lodge. Only nominees currently registered in the Boy Scouts of America and the Order of the Arrow will be considered.
- 3. Each chapter should select a youth representative on the awards committee for consideration of the award. This representative should not be nominated for the award and should not be a past recipient.
- 4. The First Vice-Chief or his designee will describe the award and allow all committee members to discuss qualifications for the award before nominees are reviewed.
- 5. <u>Nominees should be considered based on their service in the past calendar year only</u>. No seniority is given to older members, members with more experience, or members with the Vigil Honor only.
- 6. All eligible nominees will be reviewed. By secret ballot, separate votes will be taken for the youth and adviser recipient. Only committee members selected by their chapter can vote. The committee chairperson or First Vice-Chief may only vote in a tie.
- 7. If more than 50% of the ballots are for one person, the vote is final and the recipient is recorded. If no members receive a majority, the low vote-getter will be eliminated and a new secret ballot taken. If no member receives a majority after three (3) ballots, the committee chairperson or First Vice-Chief casts a vote to select the winner.
- 8. Results of the voting should be kept in confidence and transmitted in writing to the Cahuilla Lodge Key- 3 (Lodge Chief, Lodge Adviser, and Lodge Staff Adviser)
- 9. Any questions or issues not included in this text should be at the discretion of the First Vice-Chief or committee chairperson with the approval of the Cahuilla Lodge Key-3.
