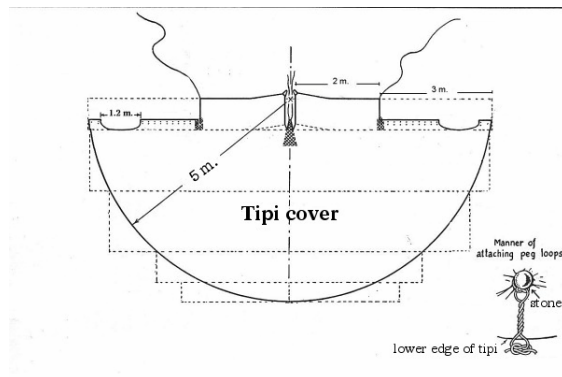


HUTUK CHAPTER MINUTES

5 November: Throwing Sticks

Throwing sticks or "rabbit sticks" were used to hunt small game by many Native Americans. The Australian Aborigines' version of the throwing stick evolved into the well-known boomerang. We will make our own throwing stick and practice throwing it (It will cost about \$5.00 for the wood). The second stick from the right in the photo was the type used by the Luiseño nation, who lived in our area.



3 December: Practice for Arrow of Light (AOL) ceremony. We need a minimum of six Arrowmen to put on the ceremony. The Webelos have worked hard to get their Arrow of Light badge and really enjoy being a part of this ceremony.

17 December: Practice AOL ceremony.

19 December: Arrow of Light ceremony. Location TBD. Those of you that are not part of the ceremony team can still come in regalia and teach Native American games to the Webelos. These Webelos are the Arrowmen of tomorrow. Let's give them a ceremony they won't soon forget!

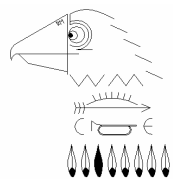
4 February: OA Elections. We will need to plan how we will visit troops in our District and administer the elections of new members to the Order of the Arrow. Please plan to assist in at least one election.
