The 2015 NOAC will be held from August 3-8, 2015 at Michigan State University in East Lansing, Michigan, and will celebrate the 100th anniversary of the Order of the Arrow. The conference fee is \$475 and includes housing, food, and program activities. It does not include travel costs. Arrowmen can travel to NOAC with a contingent from their lodge, or as a staff member supporting the thousands of Arrowmen attending in the conference.

Adults will not receive \$100 credit. **\$100 Youth credit is based off of funds raised by the Lodge to sponsor youth attending, this credit is subject to change based on current and future fundraising, in the event the Lodge is unable to fund all youth attending a balanced division of funds will be provided to all youth attending and the balance of fees will be payable by the participant.
