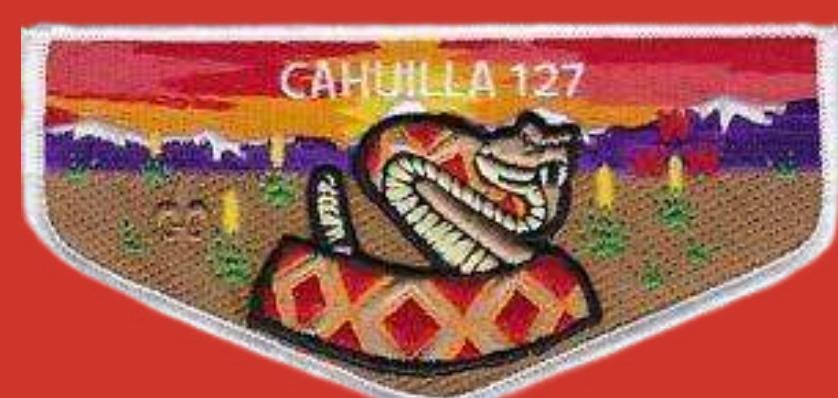
Tahquitz
