- I. **Call to Order**
 - a. Meeting was called to order at 7:48

 - a. LLD – Olson talks about a Personal Admission Statement. It articulates the individual unique direction. A personal admission answers the question, “What am I doing here?” Admission is not a narrow goal but an overall guiding direction. A personal admission is not a restraint but fuel propelling you towards success. Your personal admission shouldn’t bring you down but should guide you. You shouldn’t feel restrained by it, and it doesn’t bind you to just one thing.
 - b. Olson has Leo Dooley and Chris Olson pass out a work sheet called **Developing Your Personal Lodge Leadership Mission Statement**. He asks the lodge to fill out the first part of the paper. Then he asks the second part to be filled out by the lodge.
