- I. Call to Order
 - a. Meeting was called to order at 7:30
- II. Pledge / Obligation
 - a. Led by Phil Mandery
- III. Introductions
 - a. Introductions were made around the room
- IV. Approval of April Minutes
 - a. Leo asked for approval of May minutes
 - i. Motioned by Tahquitz, 2nd by A-Tsa Phil Mandery
- V. Lodge Officer Reports
 - a. 2nd Vice Chief – Elections are over. A letter will be sent out to all the candidates.
- VI. Chapter Reports
 - a. Wanakik – Had a meeting. They ran the Eastern Sunrise Service Project. They had 240 boys during the morning and 210 boys at night. They had 2400 service hours.
