Lodge Executive Committee (LEC) Meeting Minutes

March 27, 2008

7:45 PM: Roll Call was conducted by **Kyle Sitarski**, Lodge Secretary. All voting members present except for representatives from Yamiwa. A voting quorum was established.

7:58 PM: Introductions were conducted by all present
