**NEGAMI AWARD**- GIVEN TO THE BEST CHAPTER @  
FALL FELLOWSHIP

THIS IS BASED ON A POINT SYSTEM.

**CHAPTER EXCELLENCE AWARD**- GIVEN TO THE  
FISCAL YEARS BEST CHAPTER.

THAT YEAR'S LODGE FIRST-VICE CHIEF  
ADMINISTRATES THIS AWARD. THE GUIDELINES  
FOR THIS AWARD ARE OUTLINED BELOW. A  
JUDGING PANEL MADE UP OF THE OUTGOING AND  
IN COMING FIRST VICE-CHIEF AND THE DESIGNEE  
OF THE LODGE CHIEF. EACH WILL JUDGE EACH  
"**CHAPTER BOOK**" AND THEIR SCORES WILL BE  
AVERAGED TOGETHER TO DETERMINE THE WINNER.

1. EACH CHAPTER SHALL COMPILE A NOTEBOOK, ORGANIZED IN A MANNER CONSISTENT WITH THE ORGANIZATION OF THE CHAPTER EXCELLENCE PROGRAM (CEP).
2. THE BOOK SHALL BE DIVIDED INTO SEVEN SECTIONS, AS DESCRIBED BELOW. ALL RELEVANT INFORMATION SHOULD BE CONTAINED WITHIN THESE SECTIONS. AT THE BEGINNING OF EACH SECTION, A TYPED REPORT OF IS TO BE PLACED, SUMMARIZING THE INFORMATION LOCATED WITHIN THAT SECTION. THE SUPPORTING EVIDENCE IS TO BE PLACED AFTER THE SUMMARY.
3. SCORING: ALL SEVEN SECTIONS ARE WORTH A MAXIMUM OF NINE POINTS EACH, FOR A TOTAL OF 63 POINTS.
