CAHUILLALODGE #127 FACILITY USE POLICY

CAMP EMERSON

1. *Ordeal Weekends*

- a. All general members will receive cabins if the LEC decides allowing the use until the camp is full to capacity, except for the cook staff, persons with disabilities that require to stay overnight in a cabin, the staff (ordeal master, taskmaster, LEC members: lodge chief, first vice, second vice, third vice, secretary, treasurer), and ceremony teams will be given priority over the general members.
- b. Each cabin will be assigned a Cabin Supervisor, who will be in charge over the cabin that they stay in. Their names will be written down and recorded, so that if any vandalism or destruction of property occurs in their cabins, they will be responsible until they reveal the name of the culprit. The Cabin Supervisor will be in charge of all damage that occurs in that cabin, and will be required to notify the members of the LEC on whom the culprit was. This will ensure that the cabins are properly used, maintained, and cleaned.
- c. If cabins are not available for any reason, members are to sleep outside, either in a tent, under the stars, or in their personal vehicle.
- d. The LEC will be responsible for contacting each Chapter Chief prior to an Ordeal weekend notifying if cabins will be available or not. Chapter Chiefs will be responsible for telling their members if cabins will not be available. This can be done through a phone tree.

2. *Other Events*

- a. All staff members will receive priority to cabins including the medic, cook staff, and all other staff. If inclement weather conditions occur and the camp has enough space to accommodate all participants present, they will be allowed to stay in a cabin.
- b. Each cabin will be assigned a cabin supervisor, who will be in charge over the cabin that they stay in. Their names will be written down and recorded, so that if any vandalism or destruction of property occurs in their cabins, they will be responsible until they reveal the name of the perpetrator. The Cabin Supervisor will be liable for all damage that occurs in that cabin.

Camp Helendale
